Reinstatement of Grant of Exemption

This is a follow up to our April 11, letter of Withdrawal of Grant of Exemption Numbers 2396 and 5100D; our subsequent telephone conversations; and our April 15, meeting with representatives of the United States Army Special Operations Command (USASOC) regarding those withdrawn exemptions.

Based on the outcome of our April 15 meeting we have determined those USASOC operations, subject to the conditions and limitations stated in Exemption Nos. 2396 and 5100D, are safe and adequately justified for continuation of the relief granted in the above mentioned exemptions.

Accordingly, effective April 15, Exemption Nos. 2396 and 5100D are reinstated for USASOC, all other conditions and limitations remain the same. The stated termination dates remain the same unless sooner superseded or rescinded. This letter shall be attached to, and is part of Exemption Nos. 2396 and 5100D.
