SUBJECT: Signature Authority for Requesting Foreign Terminal Instrument Procedure (FTIP) Compliance Reviews for use of Host Nation or Commercial Products

2. Effective 1 July 2009, requests for compliance reviews of FTIP or use of commercial products must be submitted in writing and signed by the unit commander or the commander's designated risk assessment authority.

3. Requests will include the approaches, in order of priority of intended use and the date the approaches are to be flown. IAW AR 95-2, requests should be submitted 10 days prior to the mission date. FTIP and commercial product compliance reviews are time consuming and manpower intensive, especially if translation of the procedures are required. Ensuring that only the essential procedures and products are requested is necessary to prioritize use of limited resources supporting our customers worldwide.
